## 1. Lets continue with the wolves

Featured later in this Passage are some “Wolf-Like Dogs” a puppy and an adult they will be appearing on the Blog soon.

Siberian Huskies appear very similar to wolves and interestingly the owner of the dogs featured in the photos told me that their dogs have wolf ancestry.

There seems to be controversy over the genetic and evolutionary link between dogs and wolves and their common ancestor.

They are the same species the grey wolf and the domestic dogs-*Canis lupus familiaris* and wolves *Canis lupus* and potentially can inter breed- “wolf-dogs”.

Domestic dogs have been selectively bred by humans to serve their needs. Wolves have larger brains than dogs and have strong hunting instincts working in packs they can bring down large prey like deer and can rip out their throats with their large teeth.

Huskies have a long history of living and working alongside humans and show loyalty to their “human pack” as well as to their own pack.

There are some dog breeds indicated by genetic studies that are closely related to wolves e.g. Siberian Huskies , Alaskan Malamutes , Samoyeds, Afghan Hounds, Pekinese and Salukis.

### 3. Wolves & Ecology

Wolves can actually enhance ecology.

Ecology is the science of the relationship between organisms- plants and animals including microscopic plants and animals with their environment.

In basic terms a given ecosystem is conceptually drawn as a pyramid, the carnivores at the top and the wider base comprises the "primary producers"- the plants who produce food, in between are the herbivores animals that eat plants.

The carnivores are at the top of the food chain therefore.

There is a dynamic flow of energy throughout ecosystems unfortunately by over consumption, meddling and predation humans often upset ecosystems which are finely balanced with devastating results.

Fortunately there are dedicated people "in the field" working to put right generations of human error. There are also people helping future generations care for nature.
