To form an alliance with Gaia is to care for the Earth and Gaia's children-the animals in a non infringing way.

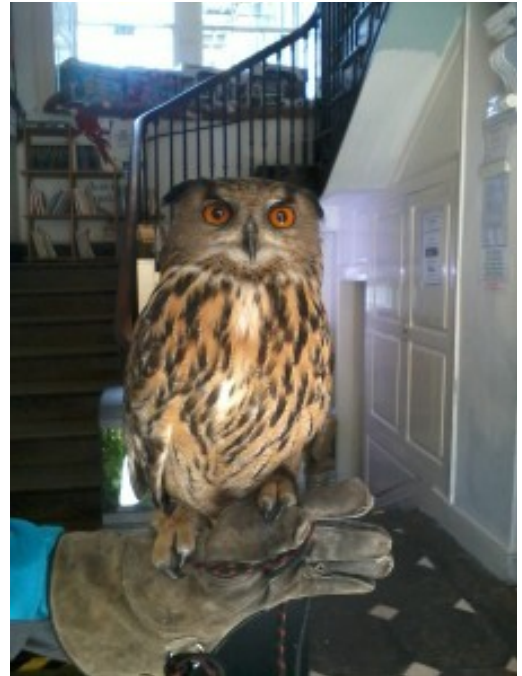
To reduce our "foot print" by reducing needless waste and suffering of the animals and environment is for people to decide, its not a rigid dictate.

## More On Wolves-

Why you may ask is the theme of wolves continuing? after all there are plenty of other animals.

The wolf has been chosen because it shows how humans persecute wolves for being wolves. We have seen how beneficial wolves can be to the ecosystem.

Wolves have been present all over the world and humans have hunted them to extinction in some regions. It is now seen that their presence can be beneficial for ecosystems and they are being reintroduced and protected in some conservation programs as you have seen in Passage Two. There is also for example the Mexican Wolf Recovery Program and much support to reintroduce the wolf to Scotland.

Humans upset ecosystems by their consumption. The commercial concentration of cattle and other animals like sheep to be reared for food for humans understandably leads to allegations of “theft” by wolves- the “wolf livestock conflict”.

There is no doubt that wolves would find physically confined domestic cattle for example whose natural defences have been bred out of them very easy prey like a supermarket offering.

The economic loss for the beef farmers in not being able to sell the cattle for slaughter and not being able to breed from stressed cattle can be considerable. In Mexico compensation is available to farmers who can prove wolf predation and loss.

Wolves are destructive of “livestock”- live- stock.

Destructive of “wild-life-”game, “game” that humans want to consume e.g. Elks, deer, moose etc. for the human hunting industry.

Hunters and trappers “manage predators” on ranches.

This is viewed conservation for farmers. We know that wolf populations have been hunted to extinction.

Wolves are carnivores, we don't need to be.

Wolves hunt in packs and can run up to 65 kilometres an hour. They are formidable apex predators at the top of the food chain.

Wolves don't recognise countries or borders why would they.

Wolves live in many different terrains and parts of the world.

Arctic wolves have been found and killed in the US many years ago they simply migrated there.

We don't need to get embroiled in opposing views we walk away from conflict we aim to understand our impact on the natural world through knowledge, feelings, what feels right to you? What do you observe and understand in a detached manner?
