Here we find ourselves in shadow land, the ivory towers..and at court, what is the mood here?

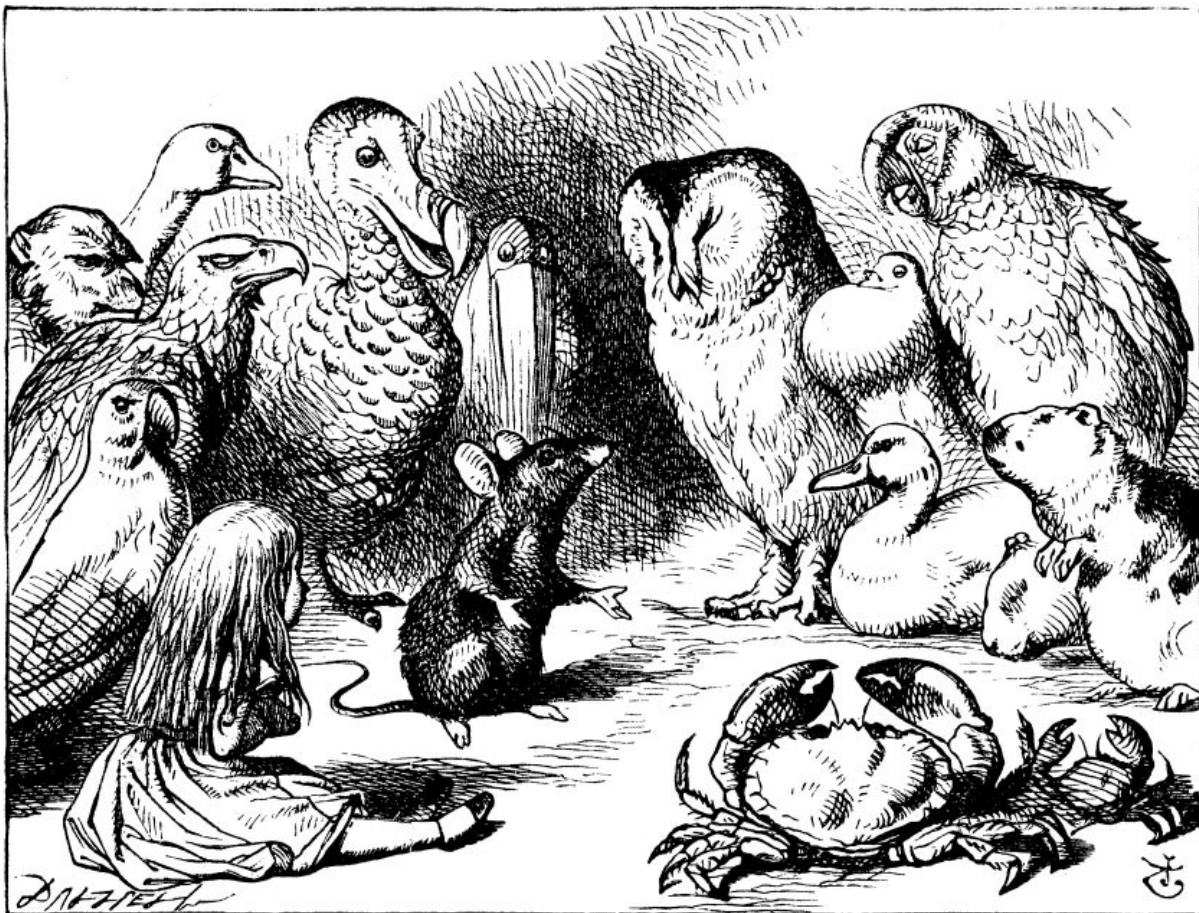
Who has anger? who has fear? who has disdain? Who is indifferent?

## More Projects

### The Wolf in Denmark :Update.

*Lets find out more from Susanne*

*Lots has been happening about the Wolf in Denmark since I wrote the first project about one year ago.*

*My dream about the wolf cubs came true in August 2017. 8 cubs were observed in the West of Jutland. At a place called Ulfborg. In the old Skandinavian language Ulf means Wolf and borg means castle. Coincidence? I don't think so. In the old pagan Norse mythology Odin was the highest god. At his feet were two Wolves Freke (The Fierce One) and Gere (The Greedy One).*

*The Wolves were here in Nature before the humans were and they have the right to be here. I feel it as a sign for Gaia taking her power back from humans. I see the Wolves as her delegates telling us we need to stop our exploitation of her resources and help her to balance Nature to what it was before we humans destroyed it because of ourselfish greed and in the name of money. That is all it comes down to in the end.*

*There's a massive debate for or against the Wolf in Denmark about 60% of the population is for the Wolf and 40% against the Wolf. The people against the the Wolf accuse the other side of having no insight of how it is to be living with the Wolf next door. Even Wolf haters from especially Norway are heating up in this debate.*

*The haters are claiming that people who want the Wolf are ignorant because they live in areas where the Wolf doesn't live eg. Cities, towns and Zealand where the Wolf hasn't arrived yet.*

*Yes...these people have not lost their sheep and lambs to the Wolf. I know it's difficult but they must do something to protect their animals. They want to take the easy way out and just kill the Wolves.*

*Now the Wolf is a political matter too and the Danish Minister of Agriculture sent an application to the EU for permission to regulate the Wolves but the answer was no. The farmers get their compensation if their animals are killed by the Wolf.*

*Employees from the Nature Agency are taking samples of saliva from the killed animals and also if owners suspect the Wolf of having injured their animals. There are many cases e.g. some Icelandic horses were bitten rather severe. In this case the DNA test showed a dog to be the attacker.*

*Another example was a 3 month old pony foal killed and eaten. This time it was the fox who was the killer.*

*The Wolf isn't quite innocent lots of lambs and sheep has been attacked though they were behind a wolf secure fence. The secure fence was only 1,10 m to 1,20 m high and the second electric wire 20 cm from the ground. I don't know who or why someone thought that the Wolf wouldn't jump such a fence.*

*I'm familiar with German Shepherds and for them jumping such a fence would be a piece of cake. This is common sense they just have to make these fences higher maybe 2 –3 m high. I think this will solve the problem.*

*I've seen interviews with farmers who have dairy cattle they are telling that their cattle are stressed because of the presence of the Wolf and not giving as much milk as usual.*

*One farmer rented a mule to protect his cows because mules always will protect the herd they are in even if it's not their own species.*

*Underneath this I am hearing the sound of "Money...money....money...."the farmers are talking so much of taking care of and protecting their animals because they care for them.*

*. But it's okay to slaughter them when they have the right size and take the calves from their mothers and take their milk and keeping calves in tiny boxes where they can't move but only stand and lie down and then send them off to the slaughter house!*

*Another thing is that people against the Wolf constantly are shouting: " The Wolf is coming....the Wolf is coming..."! Even if there isn't any danger. What if it is attacking children? I think they have read too much "Little Red Riding Hood"*

*In Germany they have 80 packs of Wolves and they haven't attacked any children.*

*Another thing are the hybrids cross between Wolf and Dog. We haven't got them in Denmark yet but they have them in Germany and they are really dangerous because they don't fear humans like the Wolf does. In Germany they are killed and we have to do the same if necessary here in DK.*

*In other countries where Wolves are living they sometimes get near to where humans and domestic animals are living because they can get easy "fast food" and that causes a problem.*

*I don't know if it's okay to regulate them or just capture them and drive them to places where they won't do any harm?*

*It's their nature not to fear humans and it could be necessary to regulate those who cause problems because without fear they are very dangerous?*

*There were found faces from Wolf on Fune the middle island of DK. It was quite unexpected because researchers didn't think the Wolf was able to swim there because of the strong current but maybe it just used the bridge.*

*Another thing is that 3 registered male Wolves have disappeared. Perhaps they went back to Germany or perhaps they were killed by hunters and buried. We'll never know.*

*Back to the cubs. People in Ulfborg are getting really afraid that there suddenly will be lots of Wolves in the area and not food enough for them and they will start attacking humans but it's a matter of ignorance.*

*One family saw 6 of the cubs in the garden of their summer residence and the cubs didn't seem afraid of people. A researcher told that the reason was that they were so*



*young and their parents haven't been teaching them to fear humans yet. Later when they get older the pack will split and the cubs will wander off to other locations to start their own packs to avoid inbreeding. How many of the cub swill survive?*

*There's so many questions that we can't answer but the time will show and hopefully we can preserve this magnificent animal in it's natural environment.*
